

Dear parents

The Prime Minister of Denmark, Mette Frederiksen, announced Wednesday night at a press conference that all schools, educational institutions and day care centers are closing as from Monday, March 16, 2020. At present for the following 2 weeks.

This means that all our schools, DUS, clubs and spare time activities in Aalborg are closed as from Monday.

The announcement is due to the spread of the virus Corona (Covid-19) and the efforts on behalf of the authorities to curb the spread of the virus.

As from Thursday and Friday:

Pupils who can, are kindly asked to stay at home as from Thursday March 12, but the schools and DUS are ready to welcome any pupils who might need to be at school and/or DUS Thursday and Friday.

If your child stays at home Thursday and Friday you don't need to inform the school. We choose to do this to not overload AULA and other means of communications in this special situation.

As from Monday March 16 - and the following two weeks:

During the circumstances of closing the schools we will establish child care plans from Monday for the pupils whose parents handle critical functions in both the public and the private sector or for pupils whose parents, despite the authorities recommendations, are unable to arrange other possibilities.

Emergency Plan

If your family is in need of child care, the school needs to be informed about that as quickly as possible and at the latest on Friday at 10 AM. This is done by contacting the school by mail, on AULA or alternatively by phone.

We are well aware of that this is a very extraordinary situation, as our Prime Minister also emphasised and we will try to find the best possible solutions for the school, while also complying to the authorities recommendations.

When we have new information, we will inform you on AULA. Until then we ask for your patience.
